

GENERAL INFO

RE-ENTRY

Attendees will be allowed to re-enter the festival up to two times until 7:30pm. No re-entry after 7:30pm will be allowed. Please remember to scan out.

WEATHER

Vegas cools down in December, with daytime highs around 60°F and evening lows around 30°F. Make sure to dress warmly! All stages will be fully covered. Outdoor offerings include food and beverage booths, merch booth, Guest Services, and activations.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Enjoy a variety of local cuisine with options for a range of dietary preferences, including vegetarian, vegan, and gluten-free. There will also be craft cocktails, beers, wine, and a variety of non-alcoholic beverages at our conveniently located full-service bars.

WATER

Complimentary filtered water refill stations will be available. Please bring your reusable water bottle (note that it must be empty upon entry and no hydration packs allowed).

RESTROOMS

There will be restroom locations offering male, female and all-gender amenities.

LOCKERS

Why stress about losing your ID, dancing with a full backpack, or carrying around new merch? Keep your items safe and secure throughout the event – and your phone fully charged – by renting a locker.

- Internally equipped with a universal phone charger, for both iPhone and Android.
- Measures approximately 14-5/8 inches high, 12-3/4 inches wide, and 18 inches deep
- Rentals are good for all day, unlimited access.
- Attendees may share and access their lockers as many times as they would like!
- Pro tip: Lockers make a great meeting point for you and your friends!

ATMS

Credit, debit, and cash are accepted by all vendors. ATMs are available onsite.

AGE RESTRICTIONS

To participate in Battleball (Dodgeball) or enter the Ball Pit you must be 18+ years old and taller than 4'11".


GETTING HERE

Intersect's festival grounds are only accessible by walking, rideshare/taxi, and public transportation. There is NO onsite parking or direct access to the festival grounds for passenger vehicles.

Las Vegas Festival Grounds

The Las Vegas Festival Grounds is located at the northwest end of the Las Vegas Strip. The address is:

RIDESHARE/TAXI

Get dropped off and picked up by an Uber/Lyft at 810 Circus Circus Drive. From there, you can walk into the south entrance.

WALKING

If you are staying on The Strip, it's an easy walk to the festival, with the views of the city along the way! To give you an idea –

- 12 minute walk to Encore at Wynn Las Vegas
- 25 minute walk to The Venetian & The Mirage
- 30 minute walk to Caesars Palace

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

LAS VEGAS MONORAIL

- Ride the Las Vegas Monorail to the Sahara Station.
- From there, walk across the Monorail pedestrian bridge above Paradise Rd.
- Make your way through the Sahara Las Vegas Hotel (formerly known as the SLS), and cross Las Vegas Blvd. to enter the festival grounds.

RTC DEUCE BUS LINE

- Take the Deuce on the Strip or the Strip & Downtown Express (SDX). Both buses stop by the Las Vegas Festival Grounds on Las Vegas Blvd.

NO PARKING

There is no parking available on site at the Las Vegas Festival Grounds.

TICKETING / BOX OFFICE

If you purchased tickets on or before November 21,

a wristband with an RFID chip will be mailed to you before the festival. The wristband is your ticket to the festival.

If you purchased tickets after November 21,

visit the box office to pick up your wristband from will call. You must show a valid form of government photo ID.

If you still need to buy tickets

you can purchase 1-Day or 2-Day tickets online via Ticketmaster. You may also purchase tickets in person at the Box Office until 10pm each day of the festival, while supplies last.

You've lost/damaged your wristband

Original purchaser or wristband registrant can go to the box office with valid photo ID for assistance. Lost/damaged wristbands are subject to a replacement fee.

Wristbands are void if tampered with or removed. Each wristband is for one person and is non-transferable for the duration of the event.





Wristband Instructions

Your RFID wristband is your ticket. Do not put your wristband on until you are on your way to Intersect and have finished reading the instructions. Do not cut, stretch, or alter your wristband. A wristband is valid for one person for the duration of the event, are non-transferable once they're applied, and are void if removed/tampered with. Once tightened, the closure cannot be loosened.



Slip loose wristband over your right wrist. Slide lock toward wrist to tighten leaving 1 finger's worth of space between wristband and wrist.




SECURITY & SAFETY

The safety and security of attendees joining us for Intersect are a top priority. Every attendee (including members of the media) will be searched prior to entry.

In the event of an emergency, look for your nearest exit signs or any way out on the perimeter of the festival grounds. Gates will be clearly marked.

And remember: if you see something, say something. Flag down any staff or law enforcement personnel if you notice something that doesn't seem quite right.

BAG POLICY

Intersect is implementing the following bag restrictions for the 2019 Festival. This is meant to enhance safety, security and entrance efficiency for attendees. While we would prefer that fans come bag free, we realize that is not always possible.

Below are the descriptions of bags that will be allowed into the festival:

- Backpacks, totes and purses must be made of clear/transparent material - Max Size 12" x 12" x 6"
- Small clutch bags and fanny packs up to 5.5" x 4.5" do not need to be clear (about the size of your hand)

ALLOWED

- Clear backpacks, bags, and totes (max size 12" x 12" x 6")
- Small clutch bags and fanny packs smaller than 4.5" x 6.5"
- Small towels (max size 11" x 18")
- Empty water containers, water bottles, misters (must be emptied prior to entrance)
- Cameras (no detachable lenses)
- Cigarettes and tobacco products (sealed)
- Earplugs
- Eye drops (sealed)
- GoPros (but no GoPro sticks or extended poles)
- Gum and mints (sealed)
- Hand sanitizer (sealed)
- Baby wipes (sealed)
- Hats
- Lighters
- Lip balm (sealed)
- Makeup (sealed)
- Phones and phone chargers
- Sunscreen (sealed, no aerosols)
- Sunglasses
- Prescription medicine (all prescription medicines must be in a marked bottle, and you must have photo-matching ID with you)

NOT ALLOWED

- Weapons or harmful objects of any kind, including edged blades and sharp, pointy, or blunt bludgeoning objects
- Toy or replica weapons, including BB, pellet, and Airsoft guns, as well as objects that shoot projectiles
- Mace, pepper spray, or other dangerous chemicals and compounds
- Explosives (including fireworks and firearm ammunition of any kind)
- Illegal drugs and drug paraphernalia
- Selfie sticks, totems, signs, posters, flags, and banners
- Unauthorized/unlicensed vendors
- Unauthorized solicitations, handbills, samplings, giveaways, etc.
- Drones and UAVs (subject to large fines)
- Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller/inline skates, and motorized vehicles
- Airboards, hoverboards, and Segways
- Outside food and alcoholic beverages
- Face masks of any kind or tactical gear
- Aluminum cans
- Glass and disposable containers
- Hydration packs
- Coolers and thermos-type containers
- Aerosol cans
- Bare feet (shoes must be worn at all times)
- Bags larger than 12" x 12" x 6"
- Animals or pets (acceptable service animals excluded)
- Laser pointers or similar focused light devices
- Laptops, tablets, and personal computers
- Blankets, sheets, and towels larger than 11" x 18"
- Seat cushions or chairs
- Lights or glow sticks
- Noise-making or distractive devices, including air horns, bullhorns, thunder sticks, and whistles
- Chains, chain wallets, or studded/spiked jewelry
- Umbrellas, tents, and parasols
- Wagons and strollers
- Video, professional photography, or audio recording equipment
- Walkie-talkies and two-way radios
- Sharpies, markers, and spray paint
- Stuffed animals, toys, and squirt guns
- Anything else that we determine in our sole discretion to be a safety or security risk.

MEDICAL/ADA

WHEELCHAIR

The venue is fully navigable for people with mobility disabilities. We encourage all guests with mobility disabilities to bring personal forms of transportation, including wheelchairs and scooters. If you need to recharge your motorized wheelchair, you may do so at the Access Center. Please bring all cords and accessories needed to charge your devices. Chargers must use a 110-volt, 20-amp circuit. Please note that we will not be providing rentals for wheelchairs or scooters.

ADA WRISTBAND

ADA wristbands are good for the whole weekend. Please do not remove your wristband for the duration of the event. One Companion Pass will be distributed per ADA wristband. If you would like to change your companion, you must bring the original Companion Pass to the Access Center to be issued a new one.

ASL INTERPRETATION

If you would like to request ASL interpretation, closed captioning, Braille or large-font print, guided tours, and/or other forms of effective communication for any performance, please contact Accessible Festivals. Note that requests must be made no later than 21 days before the event to allow for sufficient processing time.

SERVICE ANIMALS

Service animals are permitted throughout the venue. However, this does not include emotional support animals, therapy animals, or companion animals. Pets are not allowed and will be turned away. Only legitimate service animals that are properly trained and under the proper care of their owners will be provided with the appropriate credentials and allowed at the event.

MEDICAL PRESCRIPTIONS

All prescriptions must be in their original containers and must match the holder's ID. Our medical staff will check prescriptions before you enter the venue. Legal forms of ID include a driver's license, state ID, or passport.

INSULIN/MEDICAL-RELATED SUPPLIES

Please identify yourself to security before entering the venue. Our medical staff will assist you in providing a secure area to store all your items. You will be asked to show ID and provide an official doctor's note or prescription detailing the necessity of the item.
